

MINUTES
GIG HARBOR CITY COUNCIL STUDY SESSION
Thursday, September 14, 2023 – 3:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: Mayor Markley called the meeting to order at 3:08 p.m. Councilmembers Barber, Henderson, Lykins, Rodenberg, Storset, and Woock were present. Councilmember Martin arrived at 3:38 p.m.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- 1. Appointments to Design Review Board** – Mayor Markley introduced her appointments to the Design Review Board. Dean Wilder addressed the council and spoke briefly about himself and his qualifications. Kristine Isberg was unable to attend the study session.
- 2. Lift Station 1a Rehabilitation Options** – Public Works Director Jeff Langhelm introduced the city's consultant, Kennedy-Jenks. Representatives from Kennedy-Jenks provided council with a PowerPoint presentation reviewing the three options available – minimal upgrades, moderate upgrades, or full improvements – and their associated costs.

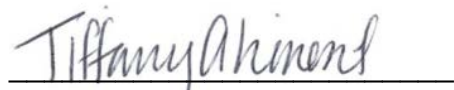
Council was supportive of the third option – full improvements.

- 3. Proposed Water Utility Rate Tiers** – Public Works Director Jeff Langhelm, Public Works Superintendent Jeff Olson, Utility Billing Technician Elijah Heen, and the city's consultant, Ashley Emery, continued their discussion with council regarding possible tier rates.

Council was supportive of implementing tiered water rates and of the general framework for those rates.
