*Council was supportive of considering a resolution in opposition of Initiative 2117. This will come before council at a regular meeting.*

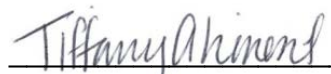
*At 4:25 p.m., council took a 5-minute break. Council returned from break at 4:33 p.m.*
