4. **Sports Complex Phase 1B Naming** – Parks Manager Jennifer Haro reviewed the three recommendations provided by the parks commission.

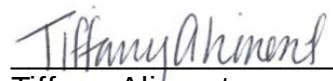
Council was supportive of the name Gertie Park.
