VOTE: Unanimously approved.

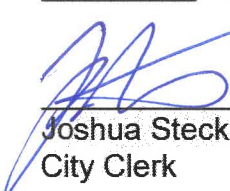
PUBLIC COMMENT ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS
