- 1. North Creek Culvert Replacement Project – Remote Site Incubator**

Council would like to proceed with the project and contract but have staff and the consultant present options other than Remote Site Incubators.

- 2. Summer Lane Wastewater Comprehensive Plan Technical Amendment:** Public Works Director presented the proposal to council and asked for council feedback.

Public Comment: Carl Halsan provided comment.

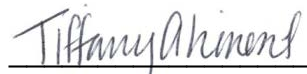
Council was supportive of the amendment.
