Public Comment: Lita Dawn Stanton, Stephanie Lile, Vicky Alsaker, John McMillan, and Ed Nadler provided comment.

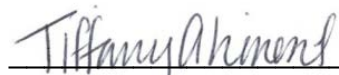
Council was supportive of conducting a historic structures report on the existing structure in the park.
