CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL Mayor Barber called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. Councilmembers Ammann, Coronado, Ekberg, Martin, Rodenberg, Stone, and Tessicini were present.

Prior to the start of the agenda, Mayor Barber asked the council to support the city signing on to support HB 5855 regarding face coverings worn by law enforcement. *Council was supportive.*

DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. **Resolution 13XX - Boat Storage Building at Ancich Park Naming Request:** Parks Manager Jennifer Haro presented the request to name the boat storage building at Ancich Park after Coach Alan Anderson of the GHCKRT.

Public Comment: Alyson Mrozinski and Scott Puckett spoke in support of the resolution.

Council was supportive of the resolution but prefers “Boat House” to “Boat Storage Building”. Staff will place a large sign on the building and a small plaque near the building explaining the history.

2. **YMCA Sports Complex Phase 1 Services Agreement:** Parks Manager Jennifer Haro presented the revised services agreement and answered council's questions.

Public Comment: Tom Movateny provided comment.

Council was supportive of moving forward with the agreement.

City Administrator Katrina Knutson announced the Homeport project will move forward this year.
