- 2. Critical Areas Code Update:** Community Development Director Eric Baker provided council with a critical areas code update presentation and answered questions.

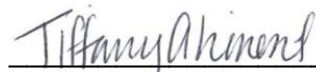
Prior to adjourning, Mayor Barber reminded council she will deliver the State of the City at the March 5 Chamber Luncheon and encouraged councilmembers to attend.
