SUBJECT: Gig Harbor Sports Complex

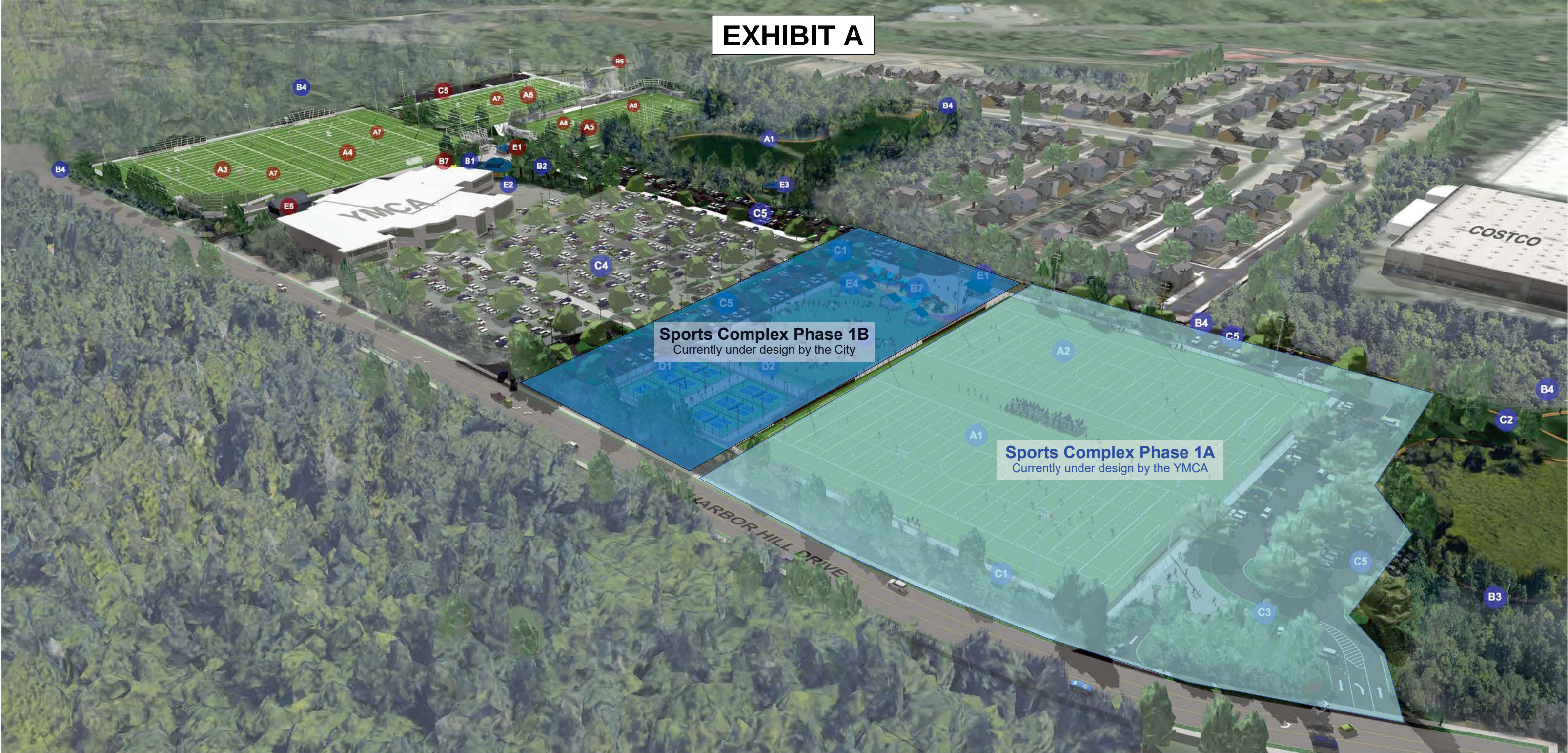
As the City proceeded with the concept, development, and advancement of the Gig Harbor Sports Complex, the City has requested input from a variety of stakeholders. These stakeholders have included City Council, user groups, and the general public.

At the April 25, 2022, Council meeting the Mayor and Council directed Staff to provide a presentation at the May 26 council study session addressing recent concerns, comments, and questions regarding the entirety of the proposed Sports Complex. The May 26 presentation will include a purpose and history of the Sports Complex, current obligations associated with the Sports Complex, a summary of the May 7 open house, a focused discussion on the Phase 1B project, and a dialog on the next steps.

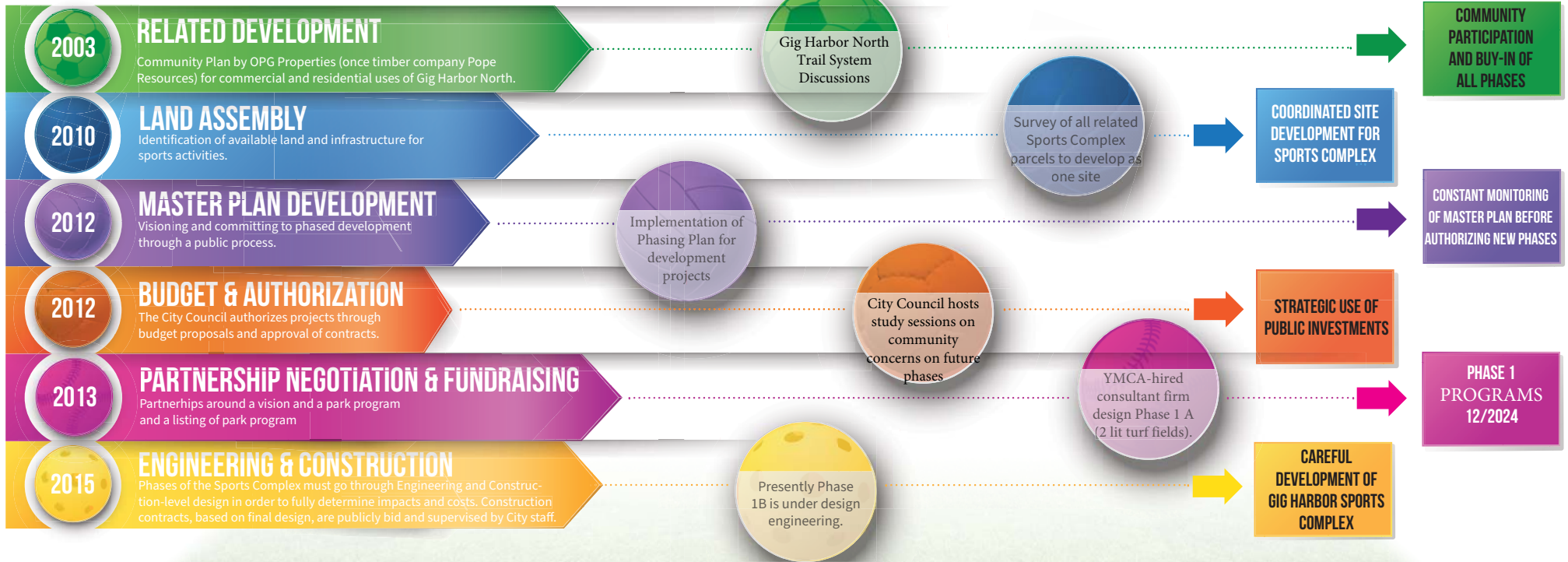

FUTURE TIMELINE

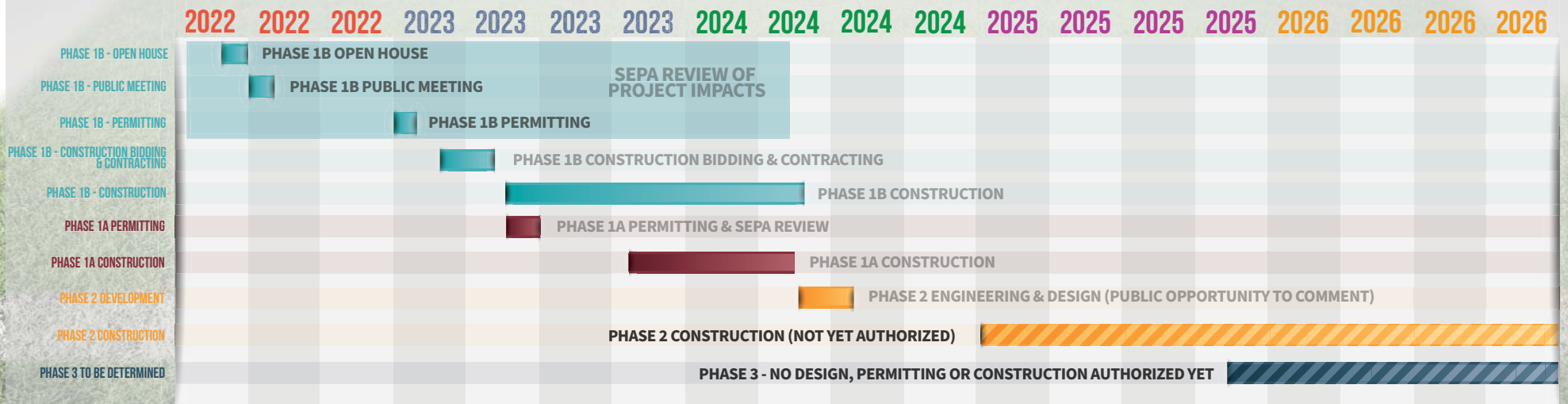


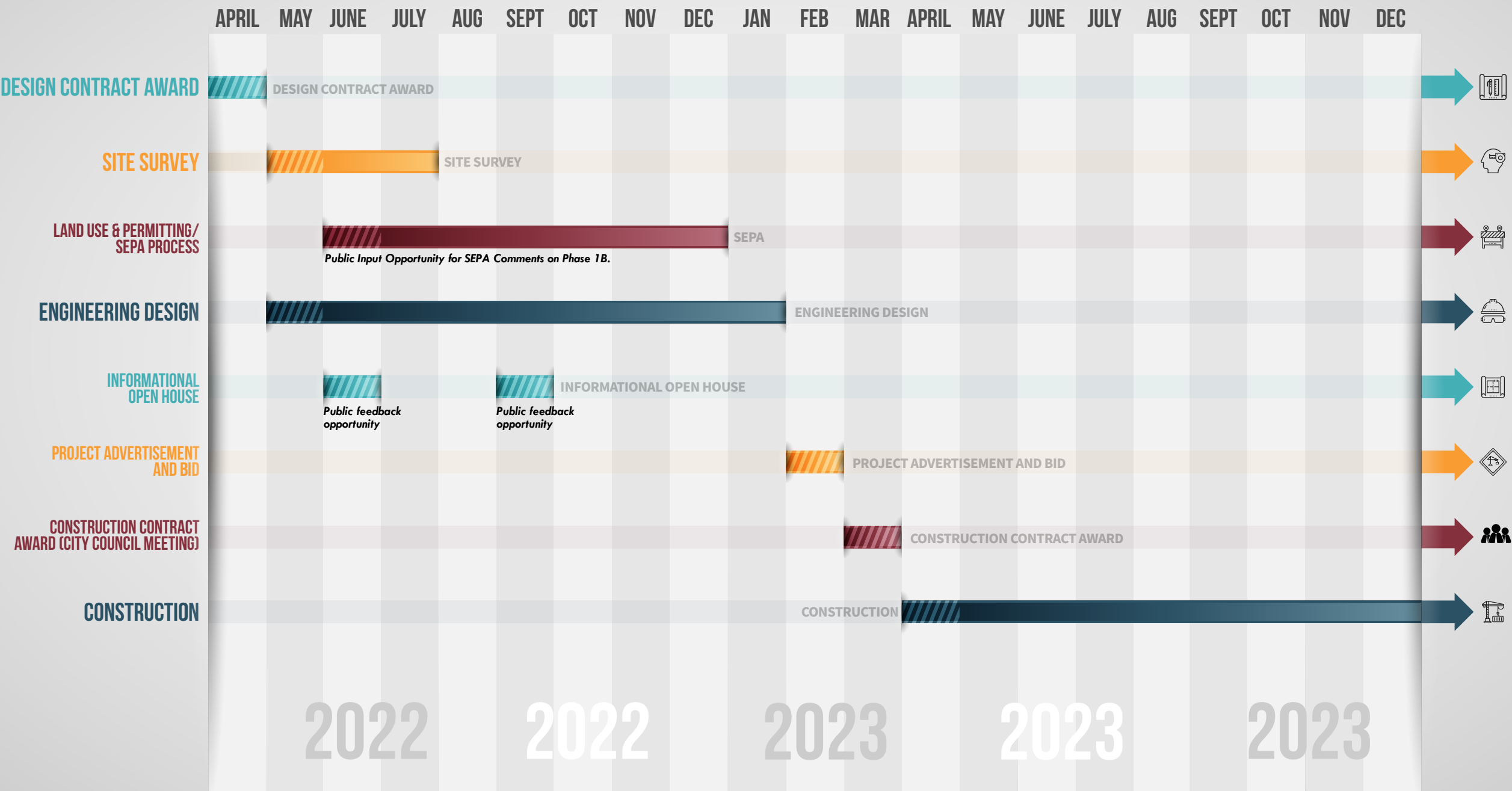

SUBJECT: POSSIBLE AMENDMENTS TO GHMC CHAPTER 8.20 FIREWORKS
DATE: CITY COUNCIL STUDY SESSION – MAY 26, 2022

INFORMATION/BACKGROUND

During the March 31, 2022, City Council Study Session, staff discussed possible amendments to GHMC Chapter 8.20 Fireworks with City Council. These amendments would grant authority to the City Fire Marshal to prohibit the discharge of fireworks on an emergency basis depending on climatic conditions. Direction was provided to staff to proceed in drafting an amendment to be brought to full council for consideration.

Council also directed staff to discuss adoption and effective date timelines for such an amendment with the City Attorney. After discussing this with the City Attorney, it became clear several legal considerations require discussion with City Council prior to moving the proposed amendment to a regular Council meeting. The City Attorney will attend the work-session to discuss these considerations with the Council in executive session.
