

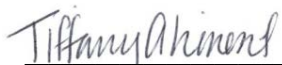
MINUTES FOR GIG HARBOR CITY COUNCIL STUDY SESSION
Thursday, November 17, 2022 – 3:00 p.m.
Community Rooms or Virtual Link

CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL: Mayor Markley called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. Councilmembers Denson, Henderson, Storset, and Woock were present. Councilmember Lykins arrived late and Councilmembers Barber and Rodenberg were excused.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- 1. 2023 Legislative Agenda Discussion** – Josh Weiss of Gordon Thomas Honeywell reviewed the proposed draft legislative agenda, asked for Council feedback, and addressed questions and concerns.
- 2. Housing Needs Assessment Presentation** – Madalina Calen, Senior Economist with Community Attributes, provided Council with a PowerPoint presentation on the city's ongoing Housing Needs Assessment and addressed Council questions. Also present were Community Development Director Carl de Simas and Senior Planner Robin Bolster-Grant.
- 3. North Creek Culvert Replacement Alternatives Discussion** – Public Works Director Jeff Langhelm and Steve Saville of Parametrix reviewed the available options and asked for feedback and general direction from Council. Council was supportive of the bridge option.
- 4. Civic Center HVAC Alternatives Discussion** – Public Works Director Jeff Langhelm and staff from MacDonald-Miller reviewed the available options for the Civic Center HVAC system replacement and asked for general Council direction. Council was supportive of System A.
