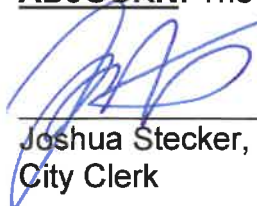
CIP Update - Public Works Director Jeff Langhelm provided an update on capital projects currently underway and introduced the new capital projects storymap.
